Cyclic voltammetry in $\mathrm{CH}_{2} \mathrm{Cl}_{2}+0.2 \mathrm{M} \mathrm{NBu}_{4} \mathrm{PF}_{6}$ at a platinum electrode of $\mathbf{6 o}$ (left), $\mathrm{E}_{1 / 2}=0.41 \mathrm{~V} / \mathrm{SCE}$ and of $\mathbf{6 c}$ (right), $\mathrm{E}_{1 / 2}=0.35 \mathrm{~V} / \mathrm{SCE} . \mathbf{6 c}$ is obtained after irradiation of $\mathbf{6 0}$ at 350 nm .

Cyclic voltammograms in $\mathrm{CH}_{2} \mathrm{Cl}_{2}$ containing $\mathrm{NBu}_{4} \mathrm{PF}_{6}$ of single-component SAMs on a gold disk electrode ( $\varnothing 1.6 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). SAMs of $\mathbf{8 o}$ (black line) and $\mathbf{8 c}$ (red line), scan rate is 1000 $\mathrm{V} \mathrm{s}^{-1}$. SAM of $\mathbf{8 c}$ is obtained after cycling of SAM of $\mathbf{8 o}$ with 5 repetitive cycles between - 0.2 and 0.8 V at $10 \mathrm{mV} \mathrm{s}^{-1}$.
