Figure 3. Standardized incidence ratios of prostate cancer. Figure 3a: Guadeloupe; Figure 3b: Martinique





Figure 4. Standardized incidence ratios of breast cancer. Figure 4a: Guadeloupe; Figure 4b: Martinique

Figure 5. Standardized incidence ratios of colorectal cancer. Figure 5a: Guadeloupe; Figure 5b: Martinique




Figure 6. Standardized incidence ratios of stomach cancer. Figure 6a: Guadeloupe; Figure 6b: Martinique




Figure 7. Standardized incidence ratios of cervical cancer. Figure 7a: Guadeloupe; Figure 7b: Martinique




Figure 8. Standardized incidence ratios of cancers of the lung and upper aerodigestive tract. Figure 8a: Guadeloupe; Figure 8b: Martinique
