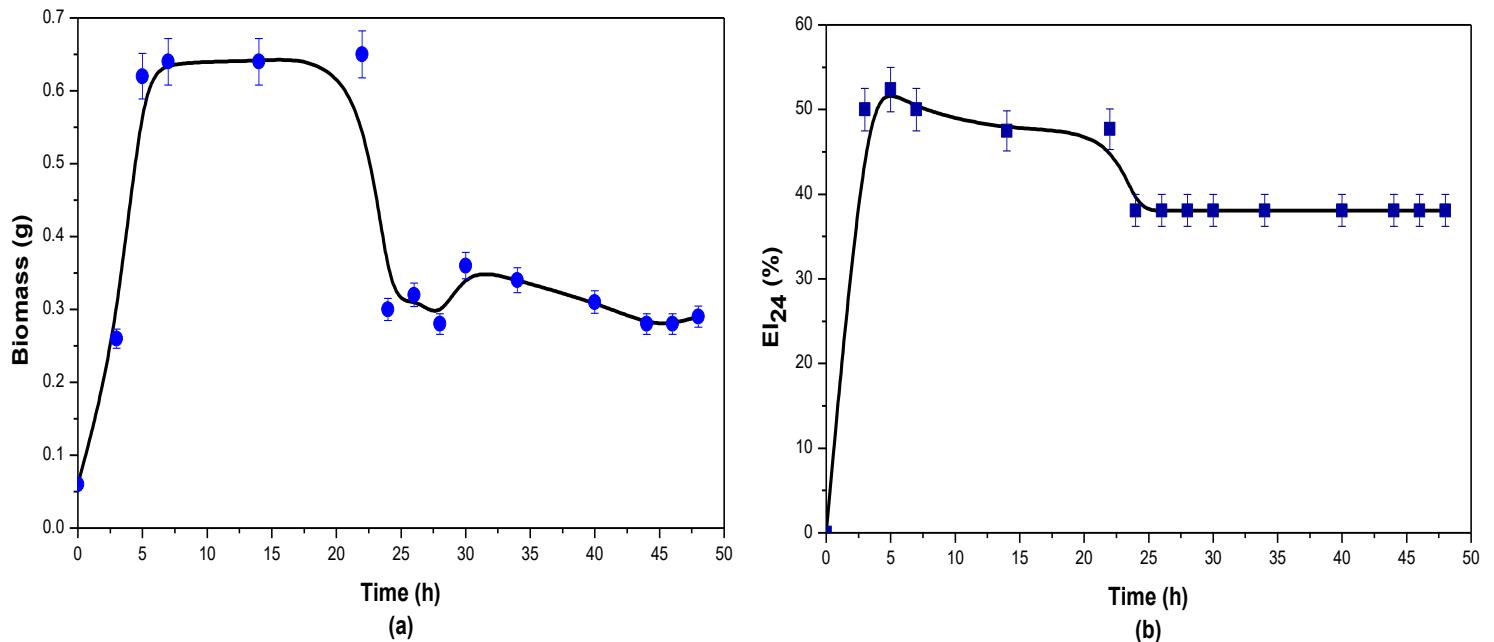


Fig. 2. Biomass (a) and Emulsification index (b) versus time ($\text{pH} = 7$, $T = 37^\circ\text{C}$, $W = 250 \text{ rpm}$, $\text{KH}_2\text{PO}_4 = 50 \text{ mmol/L}$, $p \leq 0.05$).

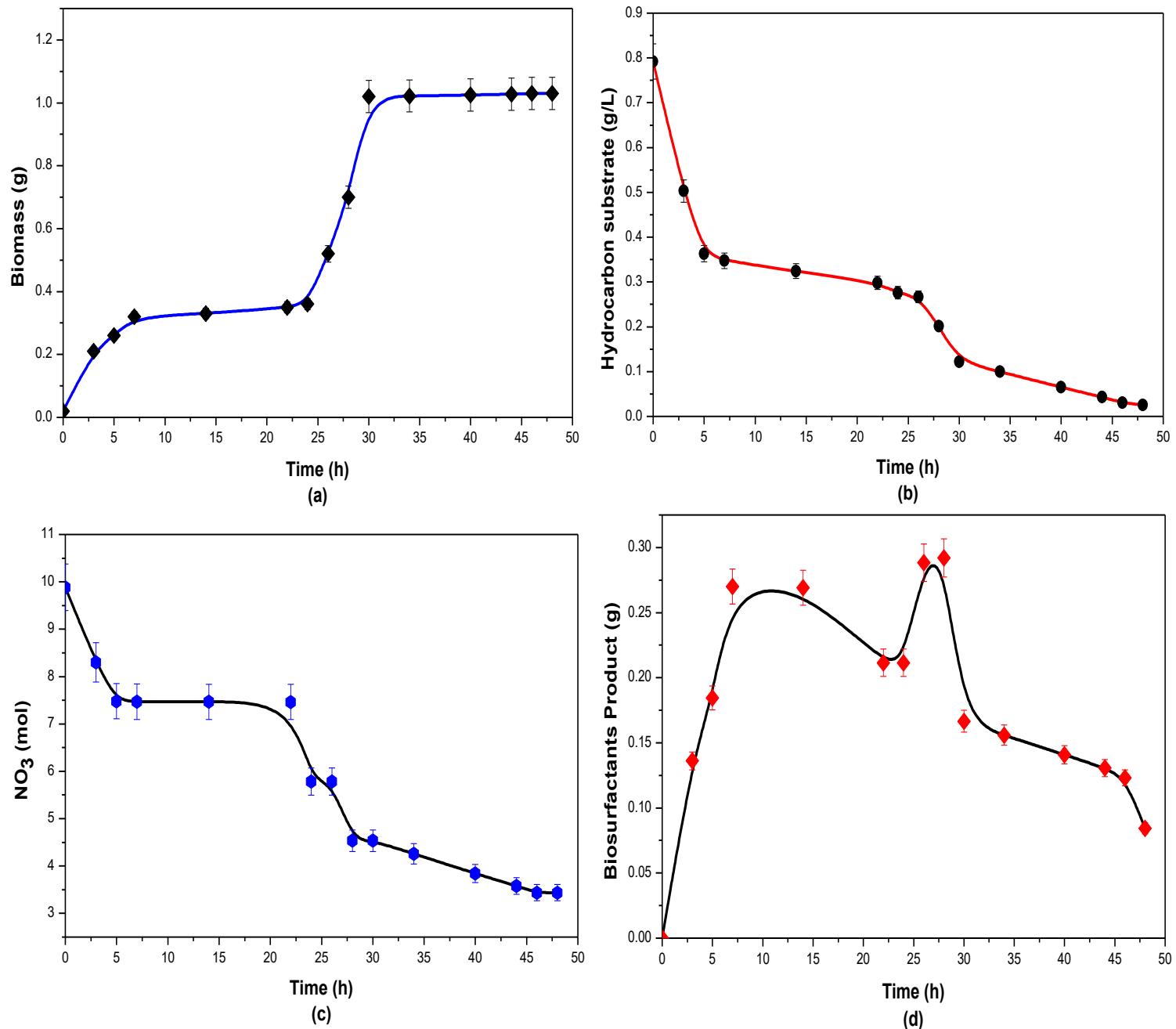


Fig. 3. Evolution of Growth (a); hydrocarbons substrate consumption (b); nitrogen uptake (c) and biosurfactant product (d) versus time (pH = 7, T = 37°C, W = 250 rpm, KH₂PO₄ = 30 mmol/L, p ≤ 0.05).

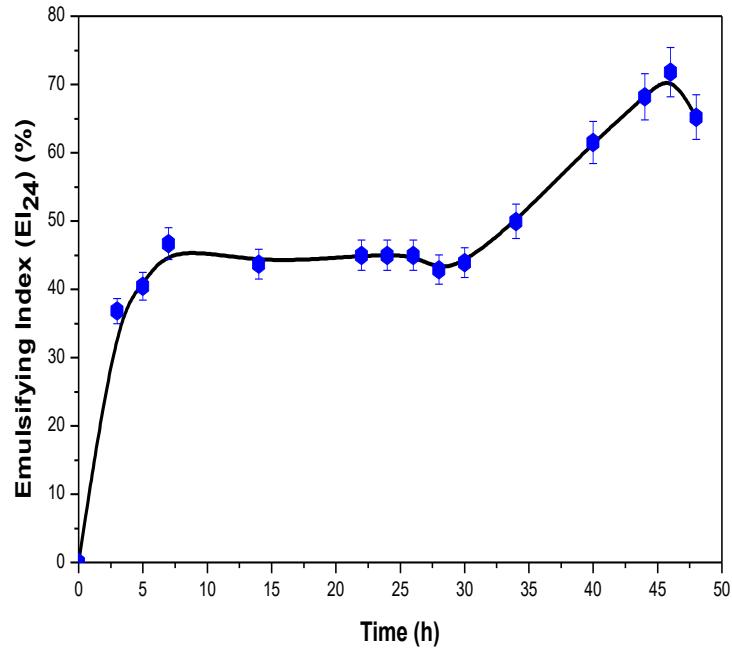


Fig.4. Emulsification index versus time ($\text{pH} = 7$, $T = 37^\circ\text{C}$, $W = 250 \text{ rpm}$, $\text{KH}_2\text{PO}_4 = 30 \text{ mmol/L}$, $p \leq 0.05$).

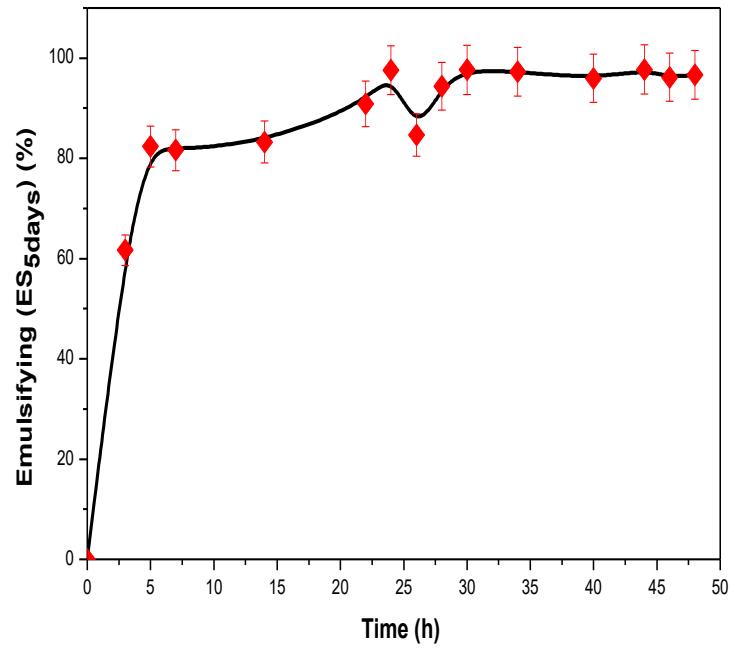


Fig. 5. Stability of the emulsion against the time after five days

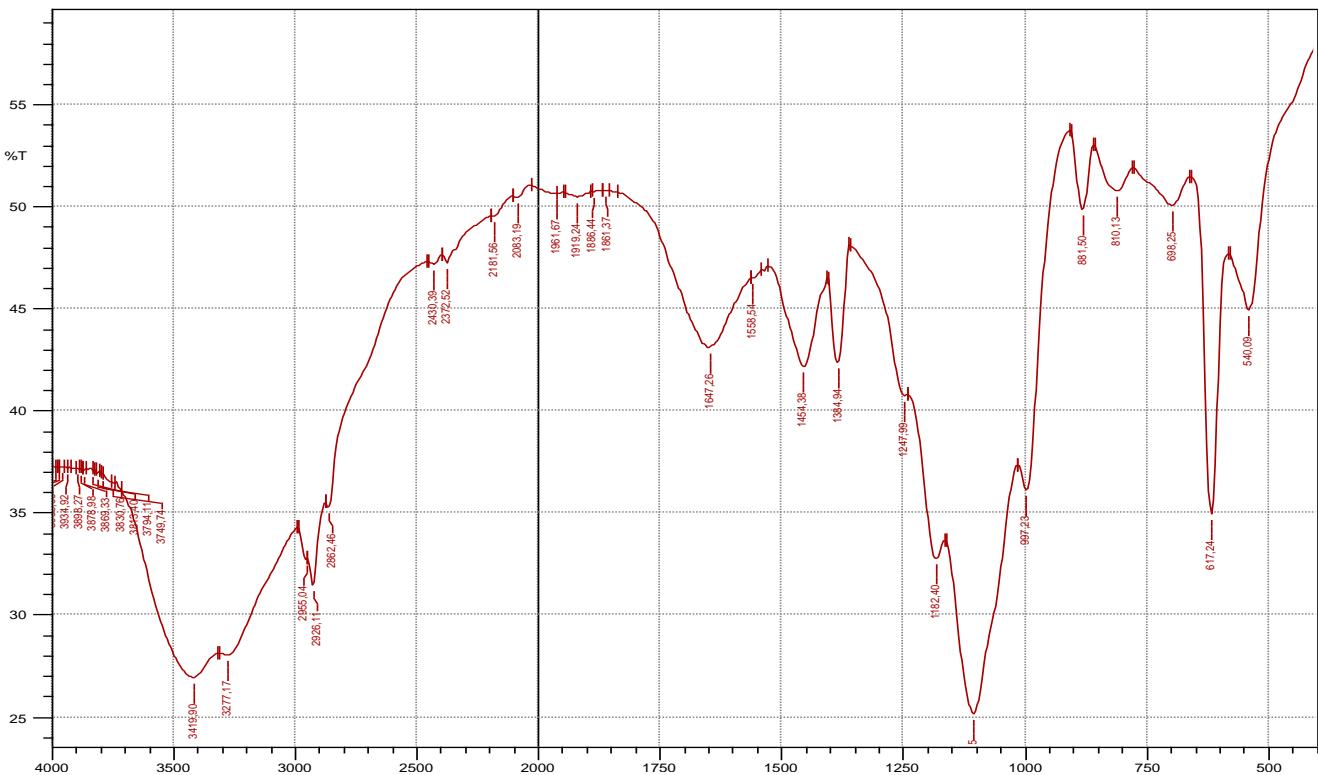


Fig. 6. Spectral IR characterization of biosurfactant product by *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* ATTC 27853.

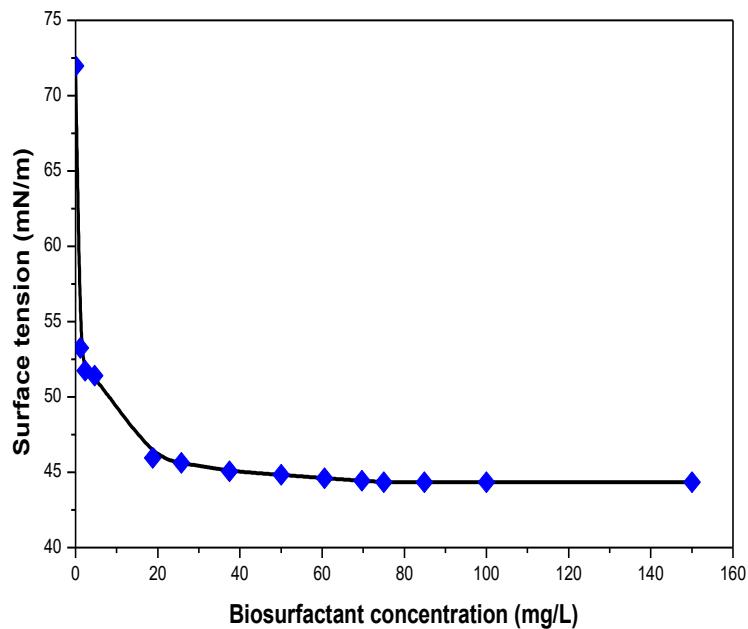


Fig. 7. Evolution of the surface tension versus the biosurfactants concentration (pH = 7, T = 37°C, W=250 rpm, KH₂PO₄ = 30 mmol/L, p ≤ 0.05).

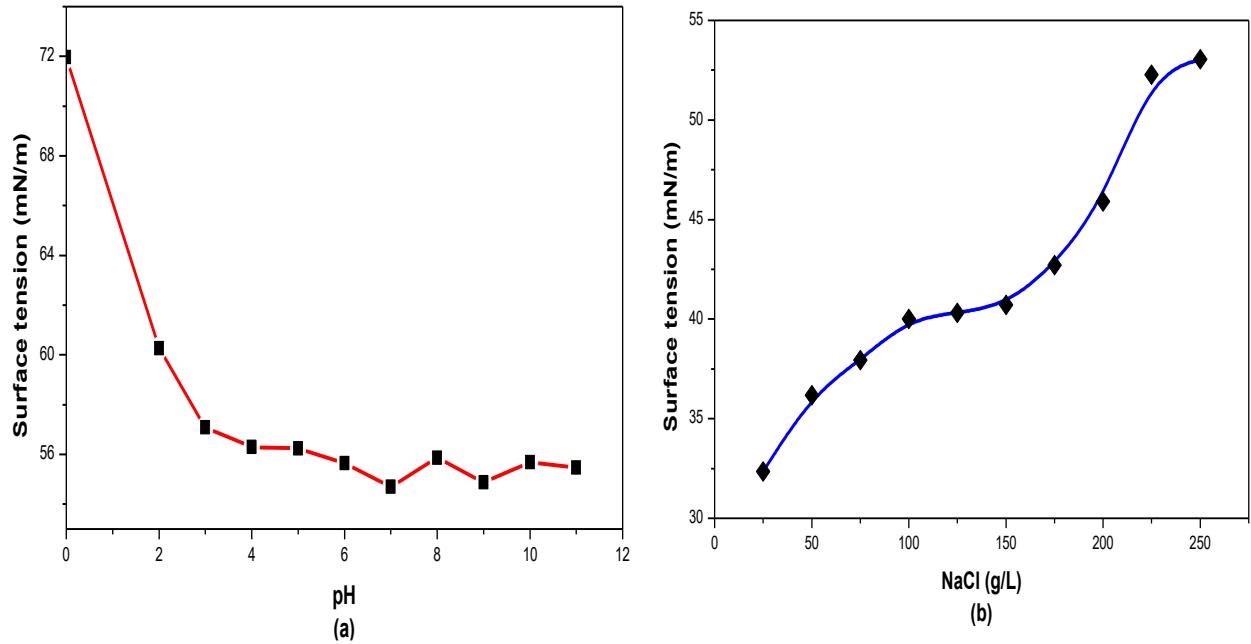


Fig. 8. Evolution of the surface tension of the crude biosurfactant versus pH **(a)** and NaCl amount **(b)** ($T = 37^\circ\text{C}$, $W=250$ rpm, $\text{KH}_2\text{PO}_4 = 30$ mmol/L, $p \leq 0.05$).
